

Major League Baseball Park District Master Plan

To help DC residents envision a new urban sports and entertainment district, DC's City Administrator convened a multi-agency, multi-consultant project team to produce an expedited draft Master Plan in six months.

Justice and Sustainability Associates, LLC worked closely with the ballpark planning and design team lead by Legion Design of the District and Chan Krieger & Associates of Boston. A major focus of the Master Plan project was a public participation strategy to engage the citizens of the District of Columbia in the planning phase for a Major League Baseball Park and the redevelopment of surrounding neighborhoods in near southeast and southwest Washington.

A primary concern of the clients in the design of such a fast-paced public involvement process was to insure the accuracy of the information being presented to the public. To meet that objective, JSA worked with District agencies to insure the participation of all relevant parties. The key components of the public participation design included an evening Neighborhood Stakeholders Informational Open House and a two-day Public Charrette designed and implemented by JSA.

Additionally, several smaller public meetings and community presentations took place as part of the overall strategy to inform, educate and involve more District residents in the planning process.
